Who are WE

The Dallas Center Dunkard Brethren Vacation Bible School, located a mile north of Dallas Center, IA on Quinlan Ave, started in 2008 with the goal to advance biblical knowledge in our youth as well as share the gospel message with the youth of the community.

Since our beginnings we have grown to around 100 students each year, welcoming children between the ages of 4 and 14. All children are welcome to attend. No prior knowledge of the bible is required for attendance. If your child has a disability we will do our best to provide adequate accommodations for them. This includes a dedicated aid if necessary.

While we do not have a dedicated curriculum provider, our bible school committee checks all materials to be sure they align with the scriptures. Over the years we have written our own materials as well as used curriculums from Answers in Genesis, Voice of the Martyrs, and some small private creators.

Our daily schedule consists of lesson time with a dedicated teacher, a craft that the children get to take home, snacks and play time, and worship as a large group. Parents are welcomed to join us for worship each evening.

Common Questions

When is VBS? Last full week of July

Who may come to VBS? Any child between the ages of 4 and 14.

What do we need to bring? Your child should arrive with active play shoes.

What if my child has an allergy? We ask, when you fill out the registration form, to list all allergies we should be aware of. If it is a food allergy we will with do our best to provide an appropriate snack for your child each night. However, if your child is extremely allergic it may be wise to send a small snack with your child.

What accommodations can you make for my child with a disability?

Bathrooms are wheelchair and walker accessible. There are no stairs on the property. If your child needs physical assistance, we can provide a dedicated assistant.
