## Common Questions

**Who may come to VBS?**

Any child 3 - 12 years old.

**What do we need to bring?**

Your child should arrive with active play shoes.

**Is my child required to attend all 5 evenings?**

No, we know that life is busy and understand if your child can only attend some of the evenings.

**Can I invite or bring a friend along?**

Yes! Please share the information with your friends. We love new students!

**What if my child has an allergy?**

We ask, when you fill out the registration form, to list all allergies we should be aware of. If it is a food allergy we will do our best to provide an appropriate snack for your child each night. However, if your child is extremely allergic it may be wise to send a small snack with your child.

**What accommodations can you make for my child with a disability?**

Bathrooms are wheelchair and walker accessible. There are no stairs on the property. If your child needs physical assistance, we welcome a caregiver to stay with them or we can provide a dedicated assistant if you inform us in advance.
